EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 27. APR. 1978

Pursuant to the Public Schools Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS School Districts No. 71 (Courtenay), No. 72 (Campbell River), No. 84 (Vancouver Island West), and No. 85 (Vancouver Island North) were authorized by Order-in-Council 1660, approved May 8th, 1975, to establish, maintain and operate North Island College; now known as North Island College Technical and Vocational Institute;

AND WHEREAS by Order-in-Council 2368, approved July 29th, 1976, School District No. 70 (Alberni) also became a participant in the operation of the said College;

AND WHEREAS the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) has passed a by-law requesting that it be allowed to participate in the operation of the said College;

AND WHEREAS the Council of North Island College Technical and Vocational Institute has passed a resolution dated 7th September 1977, approving the admission of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) to become a participant in the operation of the College;

such number of members as determined by the Minister be appointed by the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) to the College Council;

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT, pursuant to the Regulations Act, this Order be exempt from publication.

SCHOOL BY-LAW NO. 1
THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES
OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 49 (CENTRAL COAST)

A By-law to declare that the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) is in favour of joining the participating Boards in the operation of the North Island College Technical and Vocational Institute.

WHEREAS School District No. 49 (Central Coast) is located adjacent to the geographical boundaries encompassing the participating Boards in the North Island College Technical and Vocational Institute;

AND WHEREAS participation in the operation of the College will provide educational benefits to students residing in School District No. 49 (Central Coast);

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) enacts as follows:

1. That the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 49 (Central Coast) is in favour of becoming a participating Board in the operation of the North Island College Technical and Vocational Institute pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the Public Schools Act;
2. That the Board of School Trustees seek the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to become a participating Board in the operation of the College effective the earliest possible date.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "School District No. 49 (Central Coast) School By-law No. 1".


